Sir William Mallory of Studley and Hutton

(John¹⁸, William¹⁹) born c 1452 in Studley, Yorkshire, England, died July 2, 1498 in Conyers, Yorkshire, England.

Sir William married **Joan Constable** (Sir John¹⁸, Sir John¹⁹, Sir William²⁰, Sir John²¹, Sir John²², Sir Robert²³, Sir Simon²⁴, Sir William²⁵, Sir Robert²⁶, William²⁷, Robert²⁸, Ulbert²⁹, William³⁰) born 1458 in Halsham, Yorkshire, England died after 1497.

Lund is a small village between Driffield and Beverley, near Middleton-on-the-Wolds. The parish church of All Saints dates to the Norman period, but the current building is a bit of a mishmash of various styles. The nave, north aisle, and porch are 13th century, rebuilt in 1853 by Cuthbert Brodick, who designed the Town Hall at Leeds. The most striking exterior feature is the tall Perpendicular tower.

There is a rather plain Norman font and a Victorian east window by Clayton and Bell, brought to Lund from Langtoft church. The most interesting historic features are a pair of medieval effigies set on either side of the altar. On one side is the effigy of Edmund Thwaites, Lord of the Manor of Lund and Commissioner of the Peace for the East Riding from 1483-1498.



Thwaites, the son of Sir Henry Thwaites of Lund, also served as Commissioner of Array from 1484-1485 and died in 1500. The other effigy is that of Edmund's wife Joan, of whom little is known save that she died sometime before 1500.

Sir Robert Dymoke (Sir Thomas¹⁸_) was born 1461 in Scrivelsby Manor, Lancashire, England, died April 13, 1544 in Haltham, Lincoln, England. Sir Robert was the King's champion at the coronations of Richard III, Henry VII, and Henry VIII, who distinguished himself at the Siege of Tournai and became treasurer of the kingdom. His descendants acted as champions at successive coronations.

The Chapel of Scrivelsby Court, a small quaint structure, has some parts at least five centuries old. Among its tombs is that of Sir Robert Dymoke, Champion of Richard II, Henry VI, and Henry VII. On the top of his tomb is a plate of brass, on which is a figure in full armour, recumbent, with helmet under his head and a lion at his feet; above the figure is a shield containing the family arms and beneath it is this inscription:



Here lyeth the body of Sir Robert Dymoke, of Scrivelsby, Knight and Baron who departed this life the 22d day of April, in the year of our Lord God MDIXV, upon whose soul Almighty God have mercy. Amen.

William Sheldon (Ralph¹⁸, Lord John¹⁹) was born c 1509 in Beoley, Worcestershire, England, died December 24, 1570 in Skills, Warwickshire, England. He attended the Inns of Court in London where he received a legal training. Around 1526 he married the daughter of a Warwickshire wool merchant, which brought him his first contacts in local society. He made a substantial investment in monastic lands in and around Pershore and Evesham when the dissolution of the monasteries brought their possessions onto the open market. He served four monarchs in a variety of local administrative posts. He was also four times MP and four times sheriff of Worcestershire. He had influential connections, in particular his uncle, Nicholas Heath, who was successively bishop of Rochester, Worcester and then Archbishop of York and Lord Chancellor until 1559. William's second marriage, around 1554, possibly opened the way for a connection to Robert Dudley, earl of Leicester, Queen Elizabeth's favorite. William died in 1570 and was buried at Beoley with some splendor. Much later his son, Ralph, erected the tomb and composed his father's epitaph. William Sheldon was one of many Elizabethans who thought it was practical to encourage the settlement of 'stranger' - meaning foreign born - craftsmen, skilled in the manufacture of luxury goods such as glass-making, wood carving, engraving, printing, painting, weaving of woollen fabrics in new ways and in tapestry weaving. As others had already done, Sheldon's solution was to bring skilled men to his property at Barcheston, offering to local men otherwise without work in the neighbourhood, incentives to re-train.
